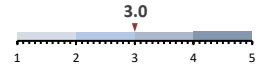

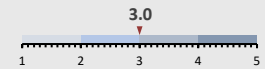
African Swine Fever

- Worldwide, there were 38,097,303 cases of [COVID-19](#) with 1,086,400 deaths reported
- In [Canada](#), the National Microbiology Laboratory reported 182,839 cases of COVID-19 and 9,627 deaths: British Columbia (10,185 confirmed, 245 deaths), Alberta (19,995 confirmed, 282 deaths), Saskatchewan (2140 confirmed, 25 deaths), Manitoba (2655 confirmed, 34 deaths), Ontario (59,139 confirmed, 3005 deaths), Quebec (86,976 confirmed, 5965 deaths), Newfoundland and Labrador (283 confirmed, 4 deaths), New Brunswick (278 confirmed, 2 deaths), Nova Scotia (1092 confirmed, 65 deaths), Prince Edward Island (63), Yukon (15), Northwest Territories (5), Nunavut (0), repatriated Canadians (13)

- [Russia](#) has reported 4 more outbreaks of HPAI H5N8 in backyard poultry in the southwestern part of the country
- In neighboring Kazakhstan, veterinary officials have reported 3 more H5 outbreaks, all in backyard poultry
